

قتن

1. قَتْنٌ : see قَتَّتْ.

قَتِينٌ : see قَتِينَتْ.

قحز

1. قَحَزَ It (an arrow) rose in the sky. (JSh, in TA, art. شخص.)

قحف

قُدُّ : see جُمَّجُمَةٌ, in two places; — and قُحْفٌ. — A glass bowl; as also جُمَّجُمَةٌ. (Az, TA in art. جمر.)

قحل

قَحُولٌ, applied to a man and to a horse, i. q. عَيْنِينَ. (IAar in TA, art. عجر.)

إِنْزَهُوْ : see إِنْزَعْلُ.

قحم

1. قَحْمٌ and تَقَحَّمٌ فِيهَا and قَحْمٌ نَفْسُهُ فِي الْأُمُورِ and تَقَحَّمَتْ He entered into affairs without consideration. (A.)

5. تَقَحَّمَتْ He experienced dearth, drought, or sterility. See an ex. voce تَبِعَتْ. — تَقَحَّمَتْ فِي الْأَمْرِ بِلَا رُؤْيَةٍ [He plunged, or rushed, into the affair without consideration]. (K, TA in art. علط.) See 1. — تَقَحَّمَتْ : see تَدَلَّتْ.

8. إِقْتَحَمَ. See 1. — Said of a young camel: see voce بَلَعٌ. — إِقْتَحَمَ الْعِمْرَاتِ : see 1 in art. عَقَبَةٌ. And إِقْتَحَمَ الْعَقَبَةَ : see عَقَبَةٌ.

قَحْبَةٌ, like قَحْبَةٌ, An old woman. See قَحْبٌ.

مُقَحَّمٌ Redundant; pleonastic; foisted in: applied to a word and to a letter. — حَرْفٌ مُقَحَّمٌ A letter inserted without reason. مُقَحَّمَةٌ is also applied in like manner to a word. [In a copy of the S, in art. بهت, I find it written مُقَحَّمَةٌ : i. q. زَائِدَةٌ. (TA in art. بهت.)

قحو

أَقْحَوَانٌ : see بَابُونَجٌ. See also a verse cited voce تَنُومٌ.

قدس

قَادُوسٌ (pl. قَوَادِيسُ) An earthen or wooden pot of a water-wheel. (PU.)

قعد

1. قَدَعَ فَرَسَهُ He pulled in his horse by the bridle and bit, to stop him; (S, K;) he curbed, or restrained, him. (S.) — هُوَ الْفَحْلُ لَا يُقَدَعُ هُوَ الْفَحْلُ لَا يُقَدَعُ : see أَنْفٌ; and see قَرَعَ.

قدم

1. قَدَّمَ الْقَوْمَ, aor. 2, inf. n. قَدِّمُ (S, Mṣb, K) and قُدِّمُوا; (K;) and تَقَدَّمَهُمُ; (S, Mṣb, K;) and قَدَّمَهُمُ; and اسْتَقَدَّمَهُمُ; (K;) He became before the people: (TA:) syn. سَبَقَهُمُ; (Mṣb;) he preceded them; went before them; took precedence of them; headed them; led them, so as to serve as an example, or object of imitation. — See أَمَّهُمُ. — قَدَّمَ الْبَلَدَ, aor. 2, inf. n. قُدِّمُوا and مَقَدَّمٌ, [He came to, or arrived at, the town, &c.] (Mṣb.) أَخَذَنِي مَا قَدَّمَ وَمَا أُخَذْتُ : see art. حَدَثٌ. — قَدَّمَ عَلَى الْأَمْرِ i. q. أَقَدَّمَ عَلَيْهِ [He advanced boldly to undertake the affair]. (TA.) See an ex. in a verse voce مَضَافٌ. — See 6.

2. قَدَّمَ زَيْدًا إِلَى الْحَائِطِ He brought Zeyd near, or caused him to draw near, or to approach, to the wall. (Mṣb.) — قَدَّمَهُ He put it forward; offered it; proffered it. — He brought, and brought forward, him or it. — قَدَّمَ لَهُ طَعَامًا He proffered, offered, or presented to him, food. — قَدَّمَ He did good or evil previously, or beforehand: (Bd, and Jel in xxxvi. 11; &c.) he laid up in store. (Bd in xii. 48.) See زَلَفَهُ. — قَدَّمَ He made foremost; put, brought, or sent, forward; he advanced him or it: he promoted him. — قَدَّمَهُ عَلَى غَيْرِهِ, inf. n. تَقْدِيمٌ. He made him, or it, to be before, or have precedence of, another, in time: and in place; i. e. he placed, or put, him, or it, before another; or made him, or it, to precede another: and in rank, or dignity; i. e. he preferred him, or it, before another; or honoured, or esteemed, him, or it, above another. (Kull, p. 104.) — قَدَّمَهُ لَكِنَّا He prepared it, or provided it beforehand, for such a thing. See KUR, xii. 48. — قَدَّمَ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ خَيْرًا He prepared, or provided in store, for himself, good, [i. e. a reward,] with God. (A and Mgh in art. حسب.) — قَدَّمَ لَهُ الثَّمَنَ He paid him in advance, or beforehand, the price. — قَدَّمَ أَنْ يَفْعَلَ كَذَا He preferred doing such a thing; syn. آثَرَ, i. e. فَضَّلَ. (M in art. أثار.) [Hence, قَدَّمَ الْعَجْزَ فِي الشَّيْءِ He preferred backwardness with respect to the thing.] (See قَرَطٌ and قَرِطٌ: and see Kull, p. 279.) — قَدَّمَ syn. with تَقَدَّمَ, q. v.: like as أَخَّرَ is with تَأَخَّرَ: so in the KUR, xli. 1. (TA, art. أخر.) — قَدَّمَ [is trans. and intrans.: for its significations as an intrans. v., see its syn. تَقَدَّمَ, and see 1:] as a trans. v. it is contr. of أَخَّرَ. (Mṣb, art. أخر.) — قَدَّمَهُ is syn. with بَدَأَ بِهِ. (Mgh and Mṣb in art. بدأ.) — قَدَّمَ تَأَذَّنَ voce : see تَقَدَّمَ. — See تَأَذَّنَ voce : see أَقْرَطَ. — قَدَّمْتَهُمُ and قَدَّمَ أَوْلَادًا. — آذَنَ

أَقْدَمَهُ and أَقْدَمَهُ He urged him forward. (Mo'allakát, 157.) — قَدَّمَ has تَقَدَّمَ for an inf. n.

4. أَقْدَمَ He was bold, or audacious. — أَقْدَمَ عَلَى الْأَمْرِ He ventured upon, or addressed himself to, the thing boldly, courageously, or daringly; (S, K;) he attempted it. — أَقْدَمَ عَلَى قَرْنِهِ He behaved boldly, courageously, or daringly, against his adversary; (Mṣb;) he attached him. — See 1. — أَقْدِمُ, (improperly إِقْدِمُ) said to a horse, Advance boldly! (S.) So rendered voce أَهَابَ, and هَبَ.

5. تَقَدَّمَ He was, or became, or went, before, or ahead; preceded; had, or took, precedence; contr. of تَأَخَّرَ, q. v. See 1. — تَقَدَّمَ إِلَى الْحَائِطِ He drew near, or approached, to the wall. (Mṣb.) — تَقَدَّمَ He advanced; went forward, or onward. (I, art. قود.) — تَقَدَّمَ عَلَى الْحَقِّ : see Bd, xviii. 27. — تَقَدَّمَ He became advanced, or promoted. — تَقَدَّمَ مِنْهُ كَلَامٌ : see فَرَطٌ: but the primary meaning is, Speech proceeded from him previously. — تَقَدَّمَ عَلَى غَيْرِهِ quasi-pass. of قَدَّمَهُ عَلَى غَيْرِهِ; He, or it, was, or became, before, or had precedence of, another, in time: and in place; i. e. he, or it, was, or became, before another; preceded another; went before another: and in rank, or dignity; i. e. he, or it, was, or became, preferred before another; or honoured, or esteemed, above another: in all these senses like تَقَدَّمَ غَيْرَهُ. See بَكَرَ. — تَقَدَّمَ فِي أَمْرٍ [He was forward in an affair] قَبْلَ فِعْلِهِ [before doing it]. (A'Obeyd, T in art. رمى.) — سَبَقَ (S, art. سبق. &c.) and contr. of تَأَخَّرَ. (TA, art. أخر.) — تَقَدَّمَ إِلَيْهِ فِي كَذَا, (K,) or بَكَدَا, (Mṣb,) or both, (Mgh,) He commanded, ordered, bade, charged, or enjoined, him respecting, or to do, such a thing; (Mgh, Mṣb, K;) as also قَدَّمَ, inf. n. تَقْدِيمٌ. (Mṣb.)

6. تَقَادَمَ is best rendered I: became old: and قَدَّمَ it was old.

8. إِقْتَدَى بِهِ He did as he did, following his example; or taking him as an example, an exemplar, a pattern, or an object of imitation. (Mṣb.) He followed his example, imitated him; &c.

10. اسْتَقَدَّمَ He went before. — اسْتَقَدَّمْتُ رِحَالَتَكَ : see art. رحل.

قَدَّمَ The human foot, from the ankle downwards. (Mgh.) — قَدَّمَ رَأْسَهُ فِي الْعِلْمِ : see art. رَسَخَ. — عَلَى قَدَمِ عَظِيمٍ On an excellent foundation. — فُلَانٌ عَلَى قَدَمِ فُلَانٍ Such a one is successor of such a one.
