

unfixed, loose, mobile, unquiet, or restless; it did not settle, become fixed or motionless or quiet or at rest, or it did not rest or remain or continue, in its place. (TA.) He, or it, became disquieted, disturbed, agitated, flurried, or in a state of unrest or commotion; syn. انزعج (S, K, TA.) and اضطرب (M, Mṣb.) — قلق إليه, or القى لِقَائِهِ, see جَبَّ.

4. اقلقه He, or it, disquieted him; disturbed him; agitated him; flurried him. (S, Mṣb.) He moved it, a thing, from its place; as also قلعه. (M.)

قلق Unsteady; loose. — عبارة قلقة A loose expression. (TA &c., passim.)

قلقة Looseness in an expression. (TA &c., passim.)

قلم

قلم and قلمان and قلمان: see جلمر. — A writing-reed prepared for writing; a reed-pen.

قلمان: see قلم.

ظفر: الاظفار and مقلم الظفر.

قلمس

قلمس: see ناسي.

قلى and قلو

1. قلى and قلا He fried wheat; i. e. roasted it in a مقلى [or frying-pan or roasting-pan]. (Mgh.) — قلى with يقلى for its aor.: see ابنى. — هو يقلى البر: see برى. — قلى He roasted in a frying-pan (MA, KL) flesh-meat (MA) or anything: (KL:) and سوى signifies the same. (MA.) شواهه المقلية and قلى البر بالمقلى [i. e. he parched, or roasted, the wheat with the مقلى]. (Mgh.) The aor. is يقلى and يقلى, and the inf. n. قلى (MA, Mgh) and قلو. (Mgh.)

قلى Potash; as is shown by the explanations in the S, K, and TA. Hence our term "alkali." See حرص.

قلى A frying-pan; i. q. طاجن. (Mṣb in art. طجن.)

قم

1. قمه: see 4; and قمه, in two places.

4. اشمَل قمته والشول و اقم الفحل شوه.

R. Q. 2. تقمته I took it, or devoured it, altogether. (TA in art. عب.)

قمه Sweepings. (S, K.)

مقم A man who eats all that is upon the table. (S, K.) — مقم and مقمة: see متمر.

قمم A certain well-known vessel; arabicized from قمم; (K, TA;) a vessel of copper, in which water is heated; also called قمم; and called by the people of Syria غلاية; as also قممة (Mṣb:) or a well-known vessel of copper, &c., in which water is heated, narrow in the head: and hence, a small vessel of copper or silver or china-ware, in which rose-water is put [for sprinkling, having a long and narrow neck, with a cover pierced with a hole or with several holes]; (TA;) the vessel of the perfumer: and, with ة, a vessel of brass, having two loop-shaped handles, which the traveller takes with him: pl. قمام. (Mṣb.)

قمع

1. قماه: see قمعه.

قمع البسر What sticks to the date, around its stalk: (Mgh:) the base of the date. (Mgh, art. ذنب.) See also a use of the pl. قماع, voce دردار. — قمع الاذن The meatus of the ear: see ججلان.

قمل

1. قمل: see قمل.

4. قمل, said of the رمث: see حنط.

قمل i. q. سوس: or a kind of قراد. (Jel, vii. 130.) See ساس.

قمل: see قمل.

قمة

1. قمة, aor. ق, inf. n. قموه, i. q. قمح, q.v.

قن

قنة An isolated mountain. (K, voce جبيل.) See a verse cited in art. عز.

قنة Galbanum: so in the present day: see سكينج.

قنة: رجل انة قنة. The last word may perhaps be a mistranscription for قنة (from فن: but this I have not found in art. فن.)

قنية The state, or condition, of slavery.

قنبر

قنبري A certain herb, or leguminous plant,

(بقلة,) growing forth in the beginning of the ربيع; a Nabathæan word; called in Arabic تملول [correctly تملول] and غملول; eaten by men; and called in Pers. برغشت [correctly برغشت]; called by the people of Ghazneh ثرند: (O:) correctly with teshdeed to the ن, though in most of the copies of the K without teshdeed; and with kees to the ب, as in the Tekmileh. (TA.) See غملول.

قنبع

1. قنبع, said of seed-produce or corn: see احنق.

قنبع: see ركبان السبل, voce ركب.

قنر

قنر A large, long-bodied man. (Az, in TA, voce هرذبة.)

قنس

قنس: see راسن.

قنوس The [lapping] top of an iron helmet. (K.) See دن.

قنع

5. قنع بشئ He was content with a thing. (K, voce تعصب.)

قنعان [not قنعان, as in the CK] With whom one is contented, or satisfied, (S, K,) like مقنع (S, K,) in respect of his judicial decision, or his evidence: (K:) used alike as masc. and fem. and sing. and pl. (S, K) and dual. (S.)

قناع A woman's covering worn over the خمار [or head-covering]; (Mṣb;) a woman's head-covering, wider than the مقنعة (S, K.) — قناع القلب The integument of the heart; the pericardium. (Mgh in art. خلع; and K.)

قناع, as used in the Kur, xxii. 37, accord. to some, One who asks, or begs. (TA, art. عر.)

قناع: see قنعان — قناعا — قناعا [Verily in that is a sufficiency]. (S, M, in art. سود.)

قناع: see صافح.

قنعة [and مقنع, PS] A woman's head-veil. (MA, PS.)
